- they are under age 67, or
- they are aged 67-74 and have been in paid employment for at least 40 hours in a period of not more than 30 consecutive days in the financial year, or
- they are aged 67-74, and in the last financial year ending 30 June were in paid employment for at least 40 hours in a period of not more than 30 consecutive days and their total superannuation savings is less than \$300,000.

The definition of spouse is either:

- another person, whether of the same sex or a different sex, with whom you are in a relationship that is registered under a law of a State or Territory, or
- a person who, although not legally married to you, lives with you on a genuine domestic basis in a relationship as a couple.
